As a non-profit legal aid organization, with the help of volunteers, we **fill gaps** and **meet legal needs** that other community agencies are unable to meet. VLPCNY offers free legal information, assistance, and representation in civil legal matters to low-income people throughout Central NY.

TOGETHER FOR ACCESS TO JUSTICE

In the past year, we provided assistance to **3,700** people, benefiting over **7,400** community members. We defended over 1,000 tenants in eviction court and supported marginalized communities, such as new arrivals from Afghanistan and Ukraine in pursuing asylum claims, and LGBTQ individuals fighting discriminatory treatment.
